A By-law to Repeal By-law 89-31A, being a By-law Passed to Establish the Amount of Monies Payable to the Municipality in Lieu of the Provisions of Off-Street Parking as Required in Accordance with Zoning By-law 89-25

Recitals

- The Village of Fenelon Falls Council adopted By-law 89-31A on December 4, 1989 to establish the amount of monies that needed to be paid to the Village of Fenelon Falls in lieu of the providing sufficient offstreet parking for development on private property in accordance with the parking provisions of the Village of Fenelon Falls Comprehensive Zoning By-law 89-25.
- 2. Council adopted the Downtown Parking Strategy in June 2021, which identified that additional off-street parking was not required in Fenelon Falls and recommended that the cash-in-lieu of parking by-law was no longer required.
- 3. Council deems it appropriate to repeal By-law 89-31A as it is no longer required.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2022-___.

Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

1.01 **Definitions**: In this by-law,

"City", "City of Kawartha Lakes" or "Kawartha Lakes" means The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes and includes its entire geographic area;

"Council" or "City Council" means the municipal council for the City;

1.02 Interpretation Rules:

(a) The words "include" and "including" are not to be read as limiting the meaning of a word or term to the phrases or descriptions that follow.

Section 2.00: Repeals

2.01 Repeal: By-law 89-31A is repealed.

Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date

3.01	Administration of the By-law: The Director of Development Services is responsible for the administration of this by-law.
