A By-law to Repeal By-law 2022-025, being a By-law to Appoint a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for Limited By-Law Enforcement Purposes

Recitals

1. Council adopted By-law 2022-025 on February 22, 2022 to appoint Michael Kelly as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for Limited Purposes for the City of Kawartha Lakes.
2. Council deems it appropriate to repeal By-law 2022-025 due to changes in staffing.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2022-____.

Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

1.01 **Definitions:** In this by-law,

“**City**”, “**City of Kawartha Lakes**” or “**Kawartha Lakes**” means The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes and includes its entire geographic area;

“**Council**” or “**City Council**” means the municipal council for the City;

1.02 **Interpretation Rules:**

- (a) The words “include” and “including” are not to be read as limiting the meaning of a word or term to the phrases or descriptions that follow.

Section 2.00: Repeals

2.01 **Repeal:** By-law 2022-025 is repealed.

Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date

3.01 **Administration of the By-law:** The Manager of Municipal Law Enforcement and Licensing is responsible for the administration of this by-law.
