## **Background:**

This Policy was recently (September 27, 2022) the subject of a Council Report and amendments to the policy were made at that time.

However, subsequently, the City has come to an impasse on the terms in the policy with a telecommunications provider. The author of the report intends to satisfy those concerns with the proposed amendments to the policy.

## **Rationale:**

An amendment to each of sections 2.02(i), 3.03 and 4.02 is required to allow telecommunications carriers to site towers with access off unmaintained roads, and to remove the requirement that the owner sign the agreement and have it registered on title.

Access off unmaintained roads is permissible, as these sites require infrequent maintenance. Road maintenance obligations for continued access will be borne by the telecommunications provider. This recommendation is consistent with recent Council direction.<sup>1</sup>

Removing the requirement for the owner to sign the agreement and have it registered on title still entitles the City to require this in cases where the telecommunication provider in question presents a higher risk profile for default on the obligation to decommission an abandoned tower, but removes this barrier for those providers with a lower risk profile.
