A By-law to Repeal By-laws to Restrict Heavy Traffic and Load Restrictions on Roads in the City of Kawartha Lakes

Recitals

- 1. Section 10 (2) subsection 7 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, (the Act) provides that a municipality may pass by-laws to provide any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable to the public;
- 2. Section 27 (1) of the Act authorizes municipalities to pass by-laws in respect of a highway under its jurisdiction;
- 3. Section 122 (7) of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O 1990, c.H.8, as amended, provides that the municipality or other authority having jurisdiction over a highway may by by-law designate the date on which a reduced load period shall start or end and the highway or portion thereof under its jurisdiction to which the designation applies,

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2022-___.

Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

1.01 **Definitions**: In this by-law,

"City", "City of Kawartha Lakes" or "Kawartha Lakes" means The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes and includes its entire geographic area;

"Director of Public Works" means the person who holds that position and his or her delegate(s) or, in the event of organizational changes, another person designated by Council.

1.02 Interpretation Rules:

- (a) The words "include" and "including" are not to be read as limiting the meaning of a word or term to the phrases or descriptions that follow.
- 1.03 **Statutes:** References to laws in this by-law are meant to refer to the statutes, as amended from time to time, that are applicable within the Province of Ontario.
- 1.04 **Severability:** If a court or tribunal of competent jurisdiction declares any portion of this by-law to be illegal or unenforceable, that portion of this by-law shall be considered to be severed from the balance of the by-law, which shall continue to operate in full force and effect.
