A By-law to Repeal By-law 2022-182, being a By-law to Appoint a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for Limited By-Law Enforcement Purposes in the City of Kawartha Lakes

Recitals

- Council adopted By-law 2022-182 on November 22, 2022 to appoint Candace Kendrick as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for Limited By-Law Enforcement Purposes at the properties located at 189 Kent Street Lindsay, 189 Kent Street West, Lindsay (West Lot) and 165 Kent Street, Lindsay.
- 2. Council deems it appropriate to repeal By-law 2022-182 due to a request from Private Parking Control and Traffic Services/PPC Security.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2022-____.

Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

1.01 **Definitions**: In this by-law,

"City", "City of Kawartha Lakes" or "Kawartha Lakes" means The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes and includes its entire geographic area;

"Council" or "City Council" means the municipal council for the City;

1.02 Interpretation Rules:

(a) The words "include" and "including" are not to be read as limiting the meaning of a word or term to the phrases or descriptions that follow.

Section 2.00: Repeals

2.01 Repeal: By-law 2022-182 is repealed.

Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date

3.01 Administration of the By-law: The Manager of Municipal Law Enforcement and Licensing is responsible for the administration of this by-law.
