By-Law 2022-____

A By-law to Repeal By-law 2022-182, being a By-law to Appoint a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for Limited By-Law Enforcement Purposes in the City of Kawartha Lakes

Recitals

1. Council adopted By-law 2022-182 on November 22, 2022 to appoint Candace Kendrick as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for Limited By-Law Enforcement Purposes at the properties located at 189 Kent Street Lindsay, 189 Kent Street West, Lindsay (West Lot) and 165 Kent Street, Lindsay.
2. Council deems it appropriate to repeal By-law 2022-182 due to a request from Private Parking Control and Traffic Services/PPC Security.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2022-____.

Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

1.01 **Definitions:** In this by-law,

“**City**”, “**City of Kawartha Lakes**” or “**Kawartha Lakes**” means The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes and includes its entire geographic area;

“**Council**” or “**City Council**” means the municipal council for the City;

1.02 **Interpretation Rules:**

(a) The words “include” and “including” are not to be read as limiting the meaning of a word or term to the phrases or descriptions that follow.

Section 2.00: Repeals

2.01 **Repeal:** By-law 2022-182 is repealed.

Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date

3.01 **Administration of the By-law:** The Manager of Municipal Law Enforcement and Licensing is responsible for the administration of this by-law.
