| Re: | School Pedestrian Safety in Cameron |

Recommendation

That the Memorandum from Councillor Perry regarding School Pedestrian Safety in Cameron be received; and

That staff be instructed to come back with a report in Q1, 2023, indicating options as well as associated budget implications, for providing increased school pedestrian safety at Fenelon Township Public School until the reconstruction of Cameron Road scheduled for 2026; and

That this recommendation be brought forward to Council for consideration at the next Regular Council Meeting.

Rationale

Cameron Road has 40km/hr zone and school crossing signs in the approach to Fenelon Township Public School alone. No further speed reduction or pedestrian safety measures exist in front of the school. Snowbanks and parked cars are increasing the risk to safe crossing(s) for children and parents. The implementation of sidewalks have been planned for 2026 however, there is an immediate need for increased pedestrian safety especially given the number of students and families within the area.
