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Key Points



- KLPS Reserve at \$588,346 (As of August 2022)
- 350,000 from Reserves Applied to 2023 Budget
- Cost of policing CECC (2 FT Uniform) included in General Rate Portion
- Increase in WSIB Costs (70% Increase between 2021-2022)
- Increased Licensing Fees Including Province Wide Digital Evidence
