Library Overview



- 14 branches throughout the City
- Open to the public 330 hours each week / 17,000 hours a year
- 9 full time staff and 35 part time 25.8 fte
- Welcomed about 140,000 visitors to our branches in 2022
- 404,000 virtual visitors
- 544,000 interactions with patrons

2022 Highlights



- Developed new Strategic Plan (launching February 2023)
- New Bobcaygeon Library Branch opened
- Further expand partnerships in the community
- Best year for library programming ever



Bobcaygeon



- Construction began January 2022
- Open to the public November 14 2022
- Grand opening this Saturday hope to see many of you there
- Benefits of the branch
 - 5200 square feet
 - Dedicated space for programming/community meeting space
 - Fully accessible
 - Increased the collection size
 - More parking spaces

Performance Indicators



2022 saw performance indicators begin to climb back up from COVID

In-person visits to branches are still below 2019

But circulation, virtual interactions, and program attendance are all close to pre-COVID levels or higher

Value of Programming



Programming is valued highly by residents

- 2014 18% of residents attended a library program
- 2019 26% of residents attended a library program
- 2022 26% of residents attended a library program

We are targeting 30% for 2023

Value of Programming



Beyond just increased attendance

Impact on the lives of library users

Summer Reading Club – 93% maintained or increased reading skills





2023 Strategic Priorities



- Launch new strategic plan
- Continued expansion of services and programs to pre-COVID levels
- Fenelon Falls expansion
- Work to expand service levels at Dalton, Norland and Bobcaygeon branches
- Community hubs
