Did you know?

- Nurse practitioners (NP) are registered nurses with a masters degree and graduate certificate in primary health care
 - Assess (diagnostics such as x-rays, lab tests), diagnose, and manage
 - Strong emphasis on prevention & health promotion
- VON is the only Ontario <u>homecare agency</u> who provides primary health care utilizing the full scope of NP practice
- We are the only community-based employer with a dedicated NP Director
- We offer primary health care to over 10,000 Ontarians
- VON has several NP Clinic sites in Ontario; three are Ontario Health funded (one of which is the Chronic Pain Program) + 9 MOH funded (12 MOH contracts)
- VON NPs utilize a people-centered approach to guide treatment plans, empowering clients in shared decision making



Benefits of Nurse Practitioners

- NP clinics enhance access to primary care
- Sept 2022 1.8 million Ontarians do not have access to primary health care https://www.ices.on.ca/Newsroom/News-Releases/2022/Number-of-family-doctors-stopping-practice-in-Ontario-doubled-early-in-pandemic
- Published numbers of "unattached patients" often do not include patients registered to an NP
- Provide comprehensive primary care services, working to stabilize chronic diseases, reducing ER/hospital visits,911
 - Ex. Diabetes, COPD, Mental Health
- Caring for highly complex individuals
 - Taking a comprehensive approach to people as a whole
 - Considering social determinants of health in care plans



Benefits of **VON** Nurse Practitioner Clinics

- Client satisfaction surveys have demonstrated:
 - 98% rating of very good to excellent
 - 98% would recommend VON NP clinics to friends/family
- VON employs 18 Nurse Practitioners, 2 > 20 years, 1 > 8 years, 10 > 5 years evidence of excellent retention leading to greater continuity of care for clients
- Currently providing care to complex, high needs clients who are often marginalized and would otherwise be without primary care
- Offer online appointment booking, same day/next day appointments
- One of our priorities: Preventative screening assessing risk of falls, cervical and colon cancer, depression

Benefits of **VON** Nurse Practitioner Clinics

- Wider lens:
 - Our EMR connects our NP clinics provincially, ability to provide remote coverage for our NP & Medical Secretary colleagues
 - Ability to consult VON NP colleagues with expertise in specific fields:
 - Chronic pain, substance use disorder (Chronic Pain Program Windsor)
 - Diabetes Educator (Kirkfield NP: Certified Diabetes Educator)
 - Pediatrics (Northbay NP in partnership with CAS)
 - breastfeeding, palliative care, etc.
- We do home visits & virtual visits by phone or video
 - Increasing access to seniors and individuals with mobility issues



VON Nurse Practitioner Scope & Services

- Some of the NP services include:
 - Holistic/comprehensive care across the lifespan
 - Well baby/child check ups and immunizations
 - Mental health assessment & management
 - Linking clients to services within the community
 - Chronic disease management including chronic pain
 - Primary prevention
 - Prenatal care
 - Referrals to specialists
 - Preventative care and cancer screening
 - Completion of forms: i.e. ODSP applications, WSIB
 - System navigation/advocating for client needs
 - Influenza/Immunization clinics



Kirkfield NP Clinic

- NP 5 years, MS 12 years
- 618 registered clients
- Total of 2088 visits, combination of inperson, phone & video
- Clinic receives 6 to 10 calls per week requesting registration
- High needs area, reduced primary care providers
- Intent on helping the community gain access to primary care
 - Registered 160 new clients last year
 - Each intake generates a lot of work
- Phlebotomy (blood lab) on-site
 - Great community service, reduced travel, increased follow through

VON

- New NP Kristen Martens
 - Start Sept 2022
 - 227 Meet & Greet of existing clients since start
- 450 current clients
- Total of 1026 visits, combination in-person, phone & video last fiscal
- Clinic receives ~ 20 calls per week requesting registration
- Projecting to take on 200 new clients FY 2023/24; & 100 in 2024/25
 - Kristen & Ashlee (Medical Secretary) are working diligently to connect with existing clients and discharge those who have primary care elsewhere in order to increase capacity for new clients
 - So far, 97 client have been discharged

Future state/opportunities: Lindsay

- Additional NP to Lindsay clinic
 - Existing space & admin support
 - Opportunity to partner with paramedicine for unattached patients
 - Directly referral to VON NP for primary care
 - Provide care where it's needed home, office
 - Provide in home support to seniors who are waiting for LTC placement
 - Act as a bridge to permanent primary care providers



Future state/opportunities: Kirkfield

- Additional NP in Kirkfield:
- Register an additional ~ 800 new clients
- Fill the gap in primary care providers
- Hybrid model see those who are precariously housed, marginalized
- New space moving in end of January
- Plenty of space for at least a second NP (more possible)
- Medical Secretary support already in place



CANADA

Future state: broader opportunities

- Implementing specialized programs across the province:
- Chronic Pain Program
- Children's Aid Partnership: VON North Bay clinic housed in Children's Aid building
 - Provide care to unattached children involved with CAS <u>and</u> their family
 - Many have trauma, mental health & addictions challenges
 - Access to primary care improves outcomes for family & children
- VON is creating multidisciplinary hubs across Ontario bringing "one stop shopping" to Ontarians
 - primary care, RNs (IVs, dressings, well client checks), PSWs,
 Adult Day programs, senior exercise programs, Social Work,
 hospice

Cost

- NP salary & benefits ~ \$145k
- Overhead ~ \$5k would include:
 - Medical supplies
 - Travel/mileage for home visits
- Requires lobbying for funding
 - Municipalities, MOH, Ontario Health
 - Funding a year as a pilot would show the benefit
