In 2016, St. James Anglican Church started an online project with Digital Museum of Canada to tell story of its establishment and history. The archival committee reached out to the City of Kawartha Lakes to help tell the story, but asking for permission to use and photograph the Anne Langton (who was one of the original members of the church) miniature sketches which are held in the Archives at CKL. The archival committee also asked for permission to use artifacts of Maryboro Lodge - the Fenelon Museum, and permission to use graveyard behind St. James.
