Re:	Road Resurfacing within the Janetville Subdivision

Recommendation

That the Memorandum from Deputy Mayor Richardson, regarding **Road Resurfacing within the Janetville Subdivision**, be received;

That staff report back with options, recommendations and budget implications for resurfacing roads within the Janetville subdivision by Q3, 2023; and

That this Memorandum be brought forward for consideration at the next Regular Council Meeting.

Rationale

On March 9th, 2021 I brought a memorandum to council with the following concerns: The last time that the Janetville subdivision was resurfaced was around 2009. It was resurfaced using a chip and tar process as that was the existing road material at the time.

In 2014, in hamlets and villages where the existing road surfaces were chip and tar, the City began upgrading by resurfacing with asphalt.

The Janetville subdivision has become a maintenance burden to public works. The subdivision is largely built around marshy areas where the chip and tar process has not



held up. The crown on these roads has deteriorated and in some areas the water lays on the road surface furthering the deterioration.

It would be beneficial for the Engineering department to address the roads indicated and provide a course of action on how to improve them (Neals Drive, Manvers Drive, Janet Drive, Arbour Court, and William Avenue).
