

# The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes

## By-Law 2023-

### A By-law to Amend By-law 2005-328 being A By-law to Establish Speed Limits

#### Recitals

1. Council adopted Resolution **CR-** on directing amendments to By-law Number 2005-328 the Speed Limit By-law.
2. An amendment is required to change speed limits on Highways.
3. These changes require an amendment to the original by-law.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law **2023-** .

#### Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

##### Definitions:

All defined terms in the amending By-law take their meaning from By-law 2005-328 of the City of Kawartha Lakes.

#### Section 2.00: Amendment Details

- 2.01 **Schedule D:** That Schedule D to By-law Number 2005-328, Highways with a speed limit of 50 Kilometres per Hour, be amended by **adding** the following:

ROAD #	FROM	TO
Pigeon Lake Road (KL Road 17)	Verulam Road (KL Road 36)	A point 50m east of Weldon Road

#### Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date

- 3.01 **Administration of the By-law:** The Director of Engineering and Corporate Assets is responsible for the administration of this by-law. The Director of Public Works is responsible for the installation and maintenance of signs authorized by this by-law.

3.02 **Effective Date:** This By-law shall come into force on the date it is finally passed, and after properly worded signs have been erected.

By-law read a first, second and third time, and finally passed, this 18th day of April, 2023.
