A By-law to Amend By-law 2016-206, the Consolidated Fees By-law in the City of Kawartha Lakes

Recitals

1. By-law 2016-206, a By-law to establish and require payment of fees for information, services, activities and use of City property in the City of Kawartha Lakes was adopted by Council on November 8, 2016.
2. At the October 24, 2017 Regular Council Meeting, Council approved Resolution CR2017-____ for updates to Fees.
3. This by-law amends By-law 2016-206 to reflect that decision.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2017-____.

Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

Definitions:

All defined terms in the amending By-law take their meaning from By-law 2016-206 of the City of Kawartha Lakes.

Section 2.00: Amendment Details

- 2.01 **Amendment:** Section 2.06 of By-law 2016-206 be deleted and replaced with:

Annual Adjustment: The fees established in Schedules A to H to this by-law may be adjusted annually, on January 1, by the Consumer Price Index of April of the current year. The City Treasurer shall determine the annual adjustment by September 1st of each year. The fee adjustment may be rounded up within the nearest one dollar (\$1.00).

- 2.02 **Amendment:** Schedules A to H of By-law 2016-206 be deleted and replaced with Schedules A to H, attached to and forming part of this by-law.

Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date

- 3.01 **Administration of the By-law:** The Director of the City Departments are responsible for the administration of the respective department fees as approved in Schedules A to H of By-law 2016-206.
- 3.02 **Effective Date:** This By-law shall come into force on the date it is finally passed.
