Recommendation

That the Memorandum from Councillor Ashmore, **regarding Downeyville Pedestrian Warning and Crosswalk**, be received;

That Staff be requested to complete a warrant review for consideration of an east west pedestrian crossing within the Village of Downeyville and report back with options, recommendations and budget implications by end of Q2, 2023; and

That this recommendation be brought forward to Council for consideration at the next Regular Council Meeting.

Rationale

The Village of Downeyville has many students and pedestrians who walk to school, church or to local businesses from the east side of the Village to the west. Residents, have asked that a safer solution become available to assist them in crossing the highway in hopes of preventing a serious accident in the future. The addition of a crosswalk may be a potential solution. The Village is also growing and a new subdivision will put more pedestrian activity within the Village.
