### **Background:**

The following is an update on the Heritage Planning program for July 2021.

**Old Gaol Walls:** A report is going to Council at its meeting of August 10, 2021 with the Committee's recommendation regarding the proposed demolition of the courtyard walls. Council will make a decision on the Committee's recommendation at that time.

**100 Front Street Designation:** A report is going to Council at its meeting of August 10, 2021 recommending the designation of 100 Front Street East in Bobcaygeon. The Committee reviewed this designation at its meeting of July 8, 2021 and recommended the property for designation.

**398 County Road 41 Designation:** The notice period for the designation of 398 County Road 41 in Bexley has passed and no objections were received. The designation by-law for the property will presented to Council at its meeting of August 10, 2021.

**Designation Requests:** Staff have received requests for designation for properties located at 1470 Highway 7A (the Old Bethany Post Office), Bethany, 1590 Elm Tree Road, Ops Township and 15 Dodd Street, Fenelon Falls. Staff have met with and undertaken site visits for all three properties and will be preparing heritage evaluation reports for the Committee's consideration.
