Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

3.01 Administration of the By-law: The Director of Engineering and Corporate Assets is responsible for the administration of this by-law. The Director of Public Works is responsible for the installation and maintenance of signs authorized by this by-law. 3.02 **Effective Date:** This By-law shall come into force on the date it is finally passed, and after properly worded signs have been erected.
