A By-Law to Repeal By-Law 2012-317 for the Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes, being a By-Law to amend the Town of Lindsay Official Plan to Re-Designate Land within the City of Kawartha Lakes

Recitals:

- 1. By-law 2012-317 had the effect of passing Official Plan Amendment 35 to the City of Kawartha Lakes Comprehensive Official Plan 2012, which by-law redesignated the property subject to the by-law and known as the "Denfield Property" from General Employment to Residential, Parks, and Open Space;
- The amendment was appealed to the Ontario Land Tribunal and as such has not come into force and effect of the date of the passing of this by-law; and
- 3. Council considers it appropriate to repeal By-law 2012-317.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2023-___.

Section 1:00: Repeal

1.01 **Repeal:** By-2012-317 for the Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes is repealed.

Section 2:00: General Terms

2.01 **Force and Effect:** This By-law shall come into force on the date it is finally passed, in accordance with the provisions of Sections 17 and 21 of the Planning Act, as amended.
