## By-Law 2023-\_\_\_\_

### A By-Law to Repeal By-Law 2012-318 for The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes, being a By-Law to Amend the Town of Lindsay Zoning By-Law No. 2000-75 to Rezone Land within the City of Kawartha Lakes

#### **Recitals:**

- 1. By-law 2012-318 had the effect of passing a proposed zoning by-law amendment to the Town of Lindsay Zoning By-law 200-75, which amendment rezoned the property subject to the by-law and known as the "Denfield Property" from General Employment to Residential, Parks, and Open Space;
- 2 The amendment was appealed to the Ontario Land Tribunal and as such has not come into force and effect of the date of the passing of this by-law; and
- 3. Council considers it appropriate to repeal By-law 2012-318.

# Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2023-\_\_\_\_.

#### Section 1:00: Repeal

1.01 **Repeal:** By-Law 2012-318 for the Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes is repealed.

#### Section 2:00: General Terms

2.01 **Force and Effect:** This By-law shall come into force on the date it is finally passed, in accordance with the provisions of Sections 17 and 21 of the Planning Act, as amended.
