#### **LSRCA At-A-Glance**

Local conservation, restoration and watershed management organization, formed in 1951 under the Conservation Authorities Act

18 Board membersappointed in 4-year cycle by9 member municipalities

One of the fastest growing areas in Ontario

The Lake Simcoe Watershed

- Watershed is 3400 sq. km and spans 20 municipalities
- From Oak Ridges Moraine in the south to Oro Moraine in the north
- 18 major river systems that flow through the landscape to the heart of the watershed; Lake Simcoe

### New for 2024: Mandatory Programs and Services

The CAA and O. Reg. 686/21 defines three categories of Conservation Authority programs and services:

**Category 1** Mandatory programs and services that are set out by the CAA and our duties, functions, and responsibilities under the Lake Simcoe Protection Act (LSPA).

**Category 2** Municipal requested programs and services provided on behalf of the municipality under a memorandum of understanding.

**Category 3** Programs and services that LSRCA has determined to be advisable to provide to further the purposes of the CAA.

**IMPACT:** More programs are now classified as mandatory/category 1.



### New for 2024: Apportionment

New Mandatory Program: *Lake Simcoe Protection Act*. Costs are apportioned by specified municipality

Each municipal's portion of the total levy will be reset

Ensures the apportionment is consistent and fair, bringing funding equity


