Recommendation(s):

That Report CS2023-008, Bobcaygeon Legacy C.H.E.S.T. Fund 2024 allocation, be received;

That total funding in the amount of \$58,733.46 be provided, with the allocation to come from the Bobcaygeon Legacy C.H.E.S.T. Fund Reserve (3.24320), for the projects as recommended by the Bobcaygeon Legacy C.H.E.S.T. Fund Grant Committee at its November 14, 2023, as follows:

That \$11,863.24 (10% of interest earned from September 30, 2022 to August 31, 2023) be retained in the principle of the Bobcaygeon Legacy C.H.E.S.T. Fund Reserve (3.24320) for inflationary growth of the fund;

That the remaining \$48,035.69 of available funds not allocated in 2024 be available for distribution in a future year.

Background:

On November 14, 2023, The Bobcaygeon Legacy C.H.E.S.T. Fund Grant Committee met to review and recommend applications for the disbursement of 2024 funding.

Ten (10) applications were received by Committee Secretary LeAnn Donnelly prior to the posted deadline and circulated to Committee members. Applications were reviewed for completeness based on the application checklist.

The recommendations drawn from the minutes of the meeting form the basis for the findings of this report.

Rationale:

Total amount available for distribution in 2024 is \$118,632.39. There were ten (10) applications submitted, with a total request of \$80,298.63. All applications have been reviewed by the committee, and as a result one (1) application is recommended to receive full funding, and nine (9) applications are to receive partial funding. This results in a total allocation of \$58,733.46. The Committee also recommends that \$11,863.24 (10% of amount available for 2024) be returned to the principal to support growth of the fund and that \$48,035.69 (amount not recommended for disbursement in 2024 minus 10%) be temporarily returned to the fund but be available for distribution in a future year.
