Recommendation(s):

That Report CS2023-007, Lindsay Legacy C.H.E.S.T. Fund 2024 Allocation be received;

That total funding in the amount of \$430,801.73 be provided for the projects as recommended by the Lindsay Legacy C.H.E.S.T. Fund Grant Committee at its meeting of November 8, 2023, with the allocation to come from the Lindsay Legacy C.H.E.S.T. Fund Reserve (3.24310), as follows:

Background:

On November 8, 2023, the Lindsay Legacy C.H.E.S.T. Fund Grant Committee met to review and recommend applications for the disbursement of 2024 funding.

Fourteen (14) applications were received by Committee Secretary LeAnn Donnelly prior to the posted deadline and circulated to Committee members. Applications were reviewed for completeness based on the application checklist.

The recommendations drawn from the minutes of the meeting form the basis of this report.

Rationale:

Total amount available for distribution in 2024 is \$487,070.97. There were fourteen (14) applications submitted, with a total request of \$903,400.75. All applications have been reviewed by the committee, and as a result two (2) applications are recommended to receive full funding, five (5) applications are to receive partial funding, and seven (7) applications are not being recommending for funding due to requests being outside of the eligible criteria for funding and application submissions being incomplete. This results in a total allocation of \$430,081.73. The Committee recommends that the balance of interest earned of \$56,269.24 not recommended for disbursement in 2024 be carried over for use in a future year.
