By-Law 2023-

A By-Law to Authorize the Execution of an Agreement Between the County of Haliburton and The Corporation of City of Kawartha Lakes for the Delivery of Social and Housing Services

Recitals

1. Council approved the entering into of an agreement with the County of Haliburton to provide management, administration, cost-sharing and delivery of Social and Housing Services by Resolution Number CR2023-584.
2. This By-Law authorizes the execution of the Agreement as appended as Schedule 'A'.
3. This By-Law shall replace By-Law 2011-135, being a By-Law to authorize the execution of an Agreement between the City of Haliburton and the CKL for the delivery of Ontario Works, Social Housing and Child Care Services
4. This By-Law shall repeal By-Law 2011-135.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-Law 2023-_____.

Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

1.01 **Definitions:** In this By-Law;

- (a) **“City”, “City of Kawartha Lakes” or “Kawartha Lakes”** means The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes.
- (b) **“Clerk”** means the person within the administration of the City which fulfils the function of the City Clerk as required by the Municipal Act, 2001, c.25.
- (c) **“Council”** means the municipal council for the City.
- (d) **“Director of Human Services”** means the person who holds that position and his or her delegate(s) or, in the event of organizational changes, another person designated by Council;
- (e) **“Mayor”** means the Chief Executive Officer of the City.

1.02 **Interpretation Rules:**

- (a) Wherever this By-Law refers to a person or thing with reference to gender or the gender neutral, the intention is to read the By-Law with the gender applicable to the circumstances.

- (b) References to items in the plural include the singular, as applicable.
 - (c) The word “include” is not to be read as limiting the phrases or descriptions that precede it.
- 1.03 **Statutes:** References to laws in this By-Law are meant to refer to the statutes, as amended from time to time, that are applicable within the Province of Ontario.
- 1.04 **Severability:** If a court or tribunal of competent jurisdiction declares any portion of this By-Law to be illegal or unenforceable, that portion of this By-Law will be considered to be severed from the balance of the By-Law, which will continue to operate in full force and effect.

Section 2.00: Approval

- 2.01 **Approvals:** The Agreement appended to this By-Law as Schedule “A” is approved.
- 2.02 **Authorization:** The Mayor and Clerk are authorized and directed to sign the Agreement appended to this By-Law as Schedule “A”, and to affix the City’s corporate seal to them.

Section 3:00: Repeal

- 3.01 **Repeal:** By-Law 2011-135 is hereby repealed.

Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date

- 3.01 **Administration:** The Director of Human Services is responsible for the administration of this By-Law.
- 3.02 **Effective Date:** This By-Law shall come into force on the date it is finally passed.
