Background:

January 16 Committee of the Whole: A report recommending the designation of 91 William Street North under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act was approved by Committee of the Whole at its meeting on January 16. The recommendation will be ratified at the January 31 Council meeting.

January 31 Council: A large number of designating by-laws will be going forward to Council for approval at its meeting of January 31. These are the balance of the designations that were approved by Council in 2023. They by-laws are for the following properties: 13-19 Colborne Street, 21-25 Colborne Street, 38-40 Colborne Street, 39-43 Colborne Street, 4 May Street, 1473 Highway 7A, 1475 Highway 7A, 1 King Street East, and 130-132 William Street North.
