

# The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes

## By-Law 2024-\_\_\_\_

### A By-Law to Repeal By-Law 2023-158, being a By-Law to Appoint a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for the City of Kawartha Lakes

#### Recitals

1. Council adopted By-law 2023-158 on September 26, 2023 to appoint Mackenzie Smallwood as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for the City of Kawartha Lakes with responsiveness to the Short Term Rental Program.
2. Council deems it appropriate to repeal By-law 2023-158 due to changes in staffing.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-Law 2024-\_\_\_\_.

#### Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

1.01 **Definitions:** In this by-law,

“**City**”, “**City of Kawartha Lakes**” or “**Kawartha Lakes**” means The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes and includes its entire geographic area;

“**Council**” or “**City Council**” means the municipal council for the City;

1.02 **Interpretation Rules:**

(a) The words “include” and “including” are not to be read as limiting the meaning of a word or term to the phrases or descriptions that follow.

#### Section 2.00: Repeal

2.01 Repeal: By-law 2023-158 is repealed.

#### Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date

3.01 **Administration of the By-law:** The Manager of Municipal Law Enforcement and Licensing is responsible for the administration of this by-law.
