Purpose of the Application:

D20-2021-029 – Vacant Lands, Part Lots 16 and 17, Concession 10, Geographic Township of Somerville, Ward 2, now in the City of Kawartha Lakes – To consider relief under Section 45 (1) of the Planning Act, R.S.O., as amended, from the Township of Somerville Zoning By-law 78-45. The purpose and effect is to facilitate construction of a new dwelling and agricultural building in support of a nursery business on a lot absent frontage on an improved public street.

Relief sought:

1) Section 18.8.1 provides that no building or structure shall be erected in any Zone unless the lot upon which such building or structure is to be erected has a lot line which abuts an improved public street, where access can be obtained off such street; the existing lot abuts a municipal unassumed road.
