That Ratcliff Excavating & Grading be selected for the award of the Request for Quotation (RFQ) **2024-038-CQ Cedar Glen Rd Culvert Replacement** as the lowest compliant bidder;

That the deficit of \$157,490.00 (including payable HST) be financed from the uncommitted portion of the Capital Contingency Reserve (1.32248);

That subject to receipt of the required documents, the Director of Engineering and Corporate Assets be authorized to execute the agreement to award; and

That the Engineering and Corporate Assets Department be authorized to issue a purchase order.

Background:

The existing culvert is located on Cedar Glen Road approximately 118 meters north of the intersection of CKL 36 and Cedar Glen Road. It is an open, bottom reinforced concrete and structural plate corrugated steel pipe arch structure with a rise of 2.1 meters and span of 4 meters. The culvert is projecting on both the upstream and downstream ends. The culvert conveys flow from Dunsford Creek, which is a tributary of Emily Creek and is within the Bobcaygeon River sub watershed. The culvert is located within a KRCA regulated area, with the existing floodplain encroaching onto the adjacent properties to the tributary corridor.

The structure was identified for replacement through the City's inspection program for large structures. It was subsequently budgeted for design and replacement with the 2023 Capital - Culverts and Municipal Drains program, project number 983230202.

The project will replace the existing 4-meter span pipe arch culvert with a precast concrete culvert structure with a span of 5.5 meters.
