Background:

A Request for Informal Quotation was issued and closed on April 15, 2024, for the Engineering Design for the Lindsay Street South Servicing Extension.

The scope of work for this project will be to carry out a topographical and legal boundary survey, geotechnical services, and a complete design including subsurface utility investigation, preliminary design, detailed design, assistance with the Request for Quotation (RFQ) package and excess soil management requirements, for the servicing extension on Lindsay Street South in the Town of Lindsay from Logie Street to Highway 7 in accordance to the OPS Specifications. The Consultant shall extend water and sanitary sewer infrastructure so that all lands identified in the former Southeast Development Charge (DC) Study can be serviced from Lindsay Street South. The Southeast DC has been incorporated into the current City wide DC by-law.

In accordance with the Procurement Policy, single source purchases over \$121,000 must be approved by Council.

Rationale:

Valdor Engineering Inc. was the sole submission received and is the engineer of record for the Gateway Subdivision. Therefore, staff recommend the Single Source award. Rationale is for consistent alignment and servicing schematics that are required.

Other Alternatives Considered:

No other alternatives are being considered as the City's Purchasing Policy allows for a single source to ensure standardization and compatibility with existing services.
