Background:

This report addresses the updated Kawartha Lakes Municipal Accessibility Master Plan 2024-2029, attached as Appendix A to this report. It will replace the Kawartha Lakes Municipal Accessibility Master Plan that was in place from 2018-2023.

Rationale:

The purpose of the Kawartha Lakes Municipal Accessibility Master Plan is to outline what steps the City will take to prevent and remove barriers to accessibility. The Municipal Accessibility Master Plan explains how, as a public sector organization, the City will fulfill its obligations outlined in the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA) and the subsequent Integrated Accessibility Standards Regulation (IASR). As a designated public sector organization, the City must develop a written multi-year accessibility plan that is updated once every five years. This plan, along with a statement of commitment to accessibility, must be posted online and made available to the public.

To ensure that the municipality is meeting the minimum expectations, set by the province, the IDEA People Partner met with staff from each department responsible for delivering the standards outlined in the legislation including Community Services, Corporate Services, Development Services, Engineering and Corporate Assets, Public Works and The Office of the CAO. Additionally, consultations were conducted with the Kawartha Lakes Accessibility Advisory Committee and with the Senior Management Team to ensure that the corporation was not only meeting service standards, but proactively optimizing service delivery for accessibility and inclusion.

The Municipal Accessibility Master Plan is an internal working guide designed to uphold legislated standards for accessibility. The identified action items in the plan span Customer Service, Information and Communications, People Services, Transit, Engineering and Development Services to ensure that corporately, we are meeting and exceeding provincial expectations. The draft Kawartha Lakes Municipal Accessibility Master Plan 2024-2029 was formally endorsed by the Kawartha Lakes Accessibility Advisory Committee during their quarterly meeting on April 16, 2024.
