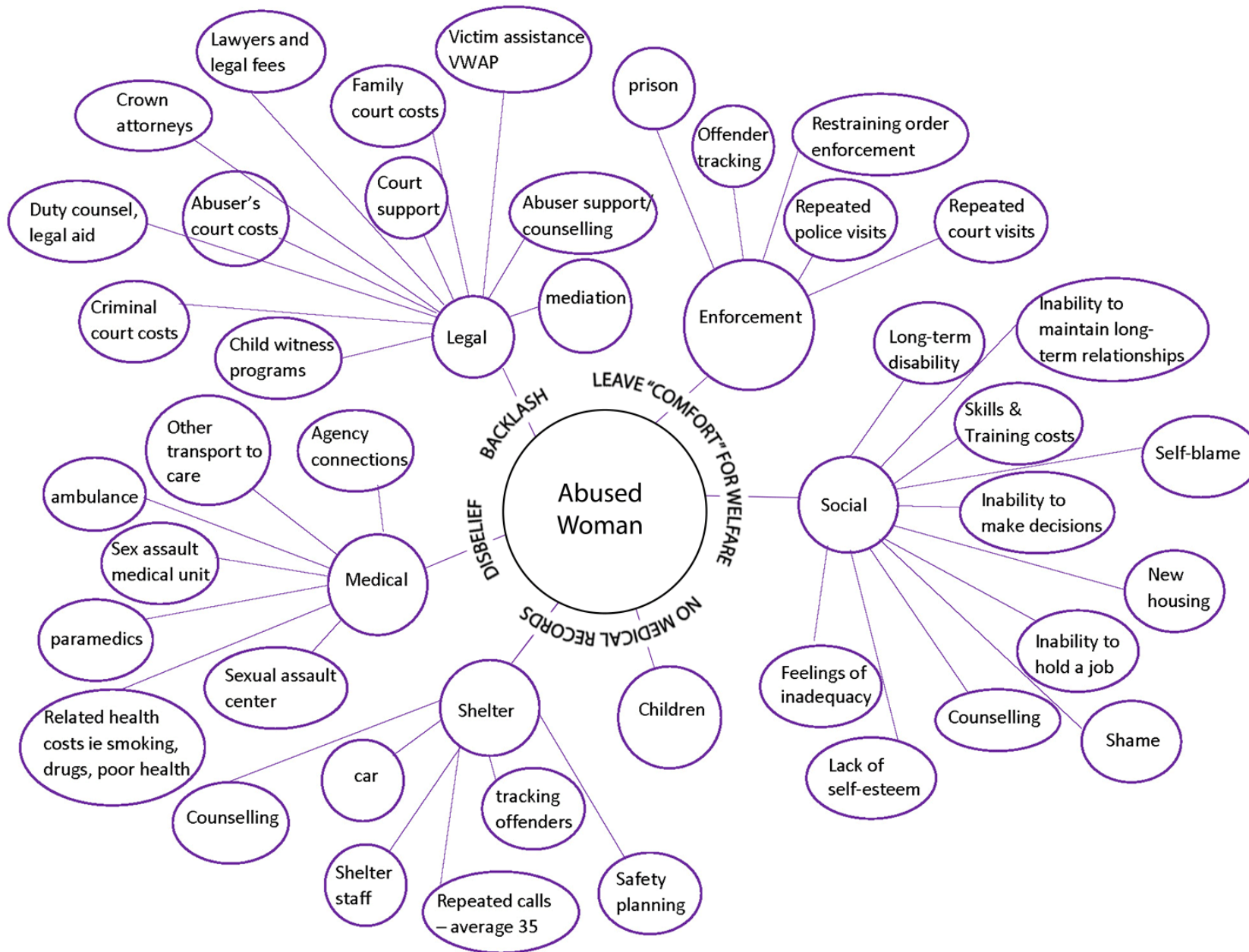
Since 1992:

- 2906 women and 23212 children received emergency shelter
- 416 women and 13 children used second-stage housing
- 40,396 crisis support calls
- 17,231 women received counselling
