

- STR owners engaged in person, letter, email, phone, vendor and advertising websites
- Agency consultations
- 800 known STR's


- Address identification dashboard


- Listing: location detail including address, and listing name (example "The Lake House)

- Web address (direct link)
- Property type
- Screenshot capture
- GPS details
- Price per night
- Owner name
- Capacity
- Documented stays (monthly)




Enforcement

- Site visits for other by-law issues
- Seasonal blitz, staff deployed to problem locations
 Application of demerit points and fees
- New Occurrence Types
 - Type: L-STRNEW, L-STRRENEW, L-STRREVOK, L-STRSUSPE
 - Sub Type: M-STRANIMA, M-STRCLEAN, M-STRFIRE, M-STRFIREW, M-STRGEN, M-STRNOISE, M-STRNOLIC, M-STRPARKI, M-STRPROPS.


STR - Stats




- Approx. 1200, STR locations identified unfiltered, includes repeats - multiple advertising platforms
- 800 unique STR locations, when filtered.
- 87% (rounded) unique locations have been identified by location details and address verified
- 14 new units added to the market and identified (reviewed last 7 days)
- 100 STR license approvals
- Complaints in the system **176**, **82** of them using vendor services (webpage, 24/7 phone line)

Processes - What have we learned?



- STR locations, advertising and usage data
- Vendor support is essential to verifying location, owner data, complaints
- Application review and circulation process creates pinch point
- STR by-law, intentionally focused
- Building permits and septic systems (new data is being collected)
- Applications initially delayed/denied for minor issues or withdrawn by applicant due to complex issues

What has changed?

- Communications internal staff and external agencies
- One point of contact for STR application intake and initial review, now supported by AA
- Application review and circulation process improved (flexibility), weekly division meetings, monthly circulation group meetings
- STR licenses issued with conditions

- Kawartha Lakes

- Council updates, staff extended individual opportunities to visit MLE to discuss STR program
- **STR program,** has been in the media (T.V. and print news, Social platforms and local community groups)
- Other municipalities, have extensively consulted with staff to build their STR by-laws and programs; some have visited to consult and view our internal processes
- Staff support, to Granicus, Host Compliance consultation with municipalities to view the platform
- AMCTO, general meeting presentation
- Presentations and discussion, Durham College, Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing

STR – Next Steps



- Complete full season operation
- Encourage more to register/license establishments
- Monitoring and actively enforcing compliance, particularly as we head into active summer season
- Refine processes
- Continue to consult with partners
- Report back to council after Thanksgiving on program
