# The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes

By-Law 2024-\_\_\_

A By-Law to Stop, Up, Close, and Sell Road Allowance Between, Concession B and Concession C, Mariposa, Lying East of Marsh Creek Road and West of Part 13 on 57R-1557, closed by A19852, Further Described as Parts 1 and 2 on 57R-11136, in the Geographic Township of Mariposa, in the City of Kawartha Lakes, (PIN: 63197-0253)

File L06-21-RS012, respecting 73 Marsh Creek Road, in the Geographic Township of Mariposa

#### Recitals

- 1. Pursuant to the Municipal Act, 2001, Council is empowered to stop up, close and to sell any part of a highway under its jurisdiction.
- 2. The land, legally described as road allowance between Concession B and Concession C, in the Geographic Township of Mariposa, lying east of Marsh Creek Road and west of Part 13 on 57R-1557, closed by A19852, in the Geographic Township of Mariposa, in the City of Kawartha Lakes, further described as Part 1 and 2 on 57R-11136 (PIN: 63197-0253), is a road allowance which has been declared to be surplus to municipal needs.
- 3. It is desirable to stop up and close that road allowance, legally described as road allowance between Concession B and Concession C, in the Geographic Township of Mariposa, lying east of Marsh Creek Road and west of Part 13 on 57R-1557, closed by A19852, in the Geographic Township of Mariposa, in the City of Kawartha Lakes, further described as Part 1 and 2 on 57R-11136 (PIN: 63197-0253), and to authorize the sale of the land to the abutting owner.
- 4. Notice of the intention of City Council to pass this By-Law was given by advertising notice duly published in the Kawartha Lakes This Week on the 8<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup>, and 22<sup>nd</sup> days of December 2022 in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Act, 2001 and City of Kawartha Lakes By-Law 2018-020, as amended.
- 5. The proposed By-Law came before Council for Consideration at the regular meeting on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of January 2023 at 1:00 p.m. and at that time no person objected to the proposed by-law nor claimed that their land would be prejudicially affected.
- 6. The sale of this land was recommended by the Committee of the Whole on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of January 2023 by CW2023-022. The recommendation was adopted at the regular Council meeting on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of January 2023 by CR2023-038.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2024-\_\_.

## Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

1.01 **Definitions**: In this by-law,

"City", "City of Kawartha Lakes" or "Kawartha Lakes" means The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes and includes its entire geographic area;

"City Clerk" means the person appointed by Council to carry out the duties of the clerk described in section 228 of the Municipal Act, 2001;

"Council" or "City Council" means the municipal council for the City;

"Manager of Realty Services" means the person who holds that position and his or her delegate(s) or, in the event of organizational changes, another person designated by Council.

### 1.02 Interpretation Rules:

- (a) The words "include" and "including" are not to be read as limiting the meaning of a word or term to the phrases or descriptions that follow.
- 1.03 **Statutes:** References to laws in this by-law are meant to refer to the statutes, as amended from time to time, that are applicable within the Province of Ontario.
- 1.04 **Severability:** If a court or tribunal of competent jurisdiction declares any portion of this by-law to be illegal or unenforceable, that portion of this by-law shall be considered to be severed from the balance of the by-law, which shall continue to operate in full force and effect.

#### Section 2.00: Road Closure and Sale

2.01 Closure and Sale: That part of road allowance, described as road allowance between Concession B and Concession C, in the Geographic Township of Mariposa, lying east of Marsh Creek Road and west of Part 13 on 57R-1557, closed by A19852, in the Geographic Township of Mariposa, in the City of Kawartha Lakes, further described as Part 1 and 2 on 57R-11136 (PIN: 63197-0253), has been declared to be surplus to municipal needs and is hereby stopped up, closed, and authorized to be sold to the abutting owner for Twenty Thousand, Four Hundred, Fifty-Five Dollars (\$20,455.00), plus HST (if applicable), plus the cost of a reference plan, advertising, appraisal, registrations, City staff time fee, legal fees and disbursements, and any other costs incurred by the City in connection to this transaction.

### Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date

3.01 **Administration of the By-law:** The Manager of Realty Services is responsible for the administration of this by-law.
