A By-Law to Provide for the Abandonment of Drainage Works in The City of Kawartha Lakes, Known as The Dykstra Municipal Drain

Recitals

- 1. The Dykstra Municipal Drain by-law, being By-law 73-18 of the former Township of Mariposa was passed pursuant to the Drainage Act;
- The City of Kawartha Lakes is of the opinion that the abandonment of the Dykstra Municipal Drain is consistent with the petition supplied to the City as per the request of three-quarters of the affected land owners pursuant to Section 84(1) of the Drainage Act;
- All of the owners of the land assessed for the drainage works have been notified of the City's intention to abandon the drainage works pursuant to Section 84(1) of the Drainage Act per the notice delivered on June 3, 2024; and
- 4. No request for an Engineer's Report with respect to the abandonment has been received pursuant to Section 84(3) of the Drainage Act.

Therfore, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2024-xxx pursuant to the Drainage Act.

- 1. The Dykstra Municipal Drain is hereby abandoned.
- 2. The City of Kawartha Lakes, pursuant to Section 84(5) of the Drainage Act, has no further obligation with respect to the drainage works known as the Dykstra Municipal Drain.
- 3. The Township of Mariposa By-law 73-18 is hereby repealed.
