Foundations have the ability to provide funding to other organizations. The purpose of this grant fund is to support the organizational costs of operating cultural facilities.

When we spoke, you had shared with me that the organization although a Foundation, operates to provide fundraising and management for the sole purpose of operating the Boyd Heritage Museum on Canal Street in Bobcaygeon.
