Petition Background: Following the recent accident that took place on the corner of Lorneville Road and County Rd 46, we

would like to request some safety measures be put in place to protect the people and children in Lorneville. Everyday people

speed down County Rd 46 as it is a long stretch of road with a consistent speed limit of 80, that is until you reach the small

hamlet of Lorneville where the speed limit drops to 60. This road is consistently used by cottagers and people heading north for

the weekend to avoid the traffic delays on Highway 12. Most people who travel this road do at least 100 and don't bother to slow


