

The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes

By-Law 2024-____

A By-law to Repeal By-law 2022-179, being a By-law to Appoint a Deputy Fire Chief and to Create and Prescribe the Duties and Responsibilities of this Office in the City of Kawartha Lakes

Recitals

1. Council adopted By-law 2022-179 on November 22, 2022 to appoint Michael Matthews as a Deputy Fire Chief for the City of Kawartha Lakes.
2. Council deems it appropriate to repeal By-law 2022-179 due to changes in staffing.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2024-____.

Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

1.01 **Definitions:** In this by-law,

“City”, “City of Kawartha Lakes” or “Kawartha Lakes” means The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes and includes its entire geographic area;

“Council” or “City Council” means the municipal council for the City;

1.02 **Interpretation Rules:**

(a) The words “include” and “including” are not to be read as limiting the meaning of a word or term to the phrases or descriptions that follow.

Section 2.00: Repeals

2.01 **Repeal:** By-law 2022-179 is hereby repealed.

Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date

3.01 **Administration of the By-law:** The Fire Chief is responsible for the administration of this by-law.
