A By-Law to Repeal and Replace By-Law 2014-102, being a By-Law to Appoint an Administrator for the City of Kawartha Lakes Home for the Aged – Victoria Manor

Recitals

- 1. The Fixing Long-Term Care Act, 2021, Section 76(1), states "Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the home has an Administrator"; and
- 2. Victoria Manor has existed as a Long-Term Care Home for many years.
- 3. Due to changes in Management at the Long-Term Care Home Victoria Manor, it is advisable to appoint an Administrator of the City of Kawartha Lakes Long-Term Care Home Victoria Manor.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2025-XXX.

Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

- 1.01 **Definitions**: In this by-law:
 - (a) "Council" means the municipal council for the City of Kawartha Lakes.
 - (b) "Victoria Manor" means the home established by the Council of the City of Kawartha Lakes under the Fixing Long-Term Care Act (2021).
- 1.02 **Statutes**: References to laws in this by-law are meant to refer to the statutes, as amended from time to time, that are applicable within the Province of Ontario.
- 1.03 **Severability**: If a court or tribunal of competent jurisdiction declares any portion of this by-law to be illegal or unenforceable, that portion of this by-law shall be considered to be severed from the balance of the by-law, which shall continue to operate in full force and effect.

Section 2.00: Appointment

2.01 **Appointment**: **Denise Bulmer** is appointed to the position of Administrator, for Kawartha Lakes Long-Term Care Home - Victoria Manor.

Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date

3.01 **Administration of the By-Law**: The Director of Human Services is responsible for the administration of this By-Law.

- 3.02 **Repeal**: By-Law 2014-102 is hereby repealed.
- 3.03 **Effective Date**: This By-law comes into force and takes effect on the 12th day of April, 2025.
