5.2 Source Separated Organics (SSO) Program

Staff advised the Committee that to date, 322 tonnes of organic waste has been diverted. Staff noted that numbers are higher due to the power outage from the March 2025 ice storm and extended power outage. Staff also advised that the grace period for participation will be ending May 1, 2025 and Miller's have been provided updated "Oops" stickers to include source separated organics (SSO) non-compliance.

5.3 Non-Eligible Sources (NES)

Staff advised the Committee that Circular Materials of Ontario will not co-collect eligible and non-eligible sources of blue box material as non-eligible sources are not mandated as part of the producer responsibility recycling collection requirements. Staff have been communicating with surrounding municipalities regarding possible joint procurement options. A letter has been sent to identified non-eligible sources to advise of the upcoming changes to recyclable material collection. Staff will continue to update the Committee as more information becomes available.
