**June 3 Committee of the Whole:** At its meeting of June 3, Committee of the Whole will receive recommendations regarding the designation of 15 Sussex Street North in Lindsay and 90 Bolton Street in Bobcaygeon.

**Connections and Conversations:** Dr. James Connolly from Trent University will be giving a presentation through Curatorial Services' Connections and Conversations series on June 17 in the Victoria Room from 6pm to 7:30pm. The presentation is entitled "Digging in the Kawarthas: Uncovering Histories at Nassau Mills and Beyond" and will explore archaeology in Kawartha Lakes and the surrounding area with particular focus on the Nassau Mills site and excavations undertaken by Connolly and his students.
