## 6.1 Reports

## 6.4 Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP) Comments

H. Dzurko advised the Committee that the Environmental Compliance Approval (ECA) amendment applications that have been submitted for the Scale and Drop off project and the Update to Contours, were withdrawn on March 12, 2025. The Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP) had requested an updated design and operations report and the City will need time to develop this report. Currently the site has operations manuals and separate design reports, this process would consolidate the documents and is the general practices for landfill sites. The City will re-submit the applications once a report is developed.

## 6.5 Monitoring Updates

K. Pantaleo advised the Committee that a site inspection was completed prior to the meeting and the Waste Technician noted that there was high water in the ditched but no blockages, the Supervisor was notified and will be inspecting the ditches regularly.

Staff noticed wind blown litter on the neighboring property. The property owner was notified and had declined our offer to clean up the material.

#### 6.6 Capital Project Updates

H. Dzurko provided an overview of the projects. The Committee was advised that the site designs for additional scales and operation improvements have been reviewed by Operations. The estimated construction costs are higher than the budgeted amount. Staff are reviewing the design to continue the project and once available, further details will be brought to the Committee.

There was no update to provide on the Environmental Assessment other then that the Engineering department is continuing to work on the request for quotations.

Staff noted that the Integrated Waste Management is still in draft and if there are any plans that impact Lindsay Ops they will be brought forward for discussion.
