St. Paul's Anglican Church is seeking financial support for the completion of the restoration of their archival collection. This collection is not simply a religious record. St. Paul's has been a member of the Lindsay and City of Kawartha Lakes community for almost 190 years. During that time, we have been a vibrant and committed member of the social, cultural, and commercial life of Lindsay and this is reflected in the documents, photographs, and film that we have collected.

For the past 60 years, volunteers have worked diligently to maintain our collection. Four years ago the archive committee realized we need professional help and so we were able to obtain funding from the federal government through the Documentary Heritage Communities Program. We engaged an archivist and we have made great progress in rehousing to preserve our records. But that funding has now expired and we need additional funding to complete the project.

### What action are you hoping will result from your presentation/deputation? \*

Our grant from DCHP allowed us to bring some basic order to the collection but it is not completed. We did apply to DCHP this year but, in a field of 159 applications, only 31 were funded. And, unfortunately, we were not one of the recipients. In the past, we have also applied to the Community Chest Fund but, again, we were denied.

We need to proceed to the next step of restoration - digitizing the collection. This will give online accessibility to the community, the province, the country, and even internationally. Without additional funding, a treasure trove of records will fall into disrepair. To that end, we are requesting the support of the City of Kawartha Lakes to assist us in this important archival record of local history with a grant of \$24,000.
